Culture Programme (2007-2013)

- **Legal Basis – Article 151, to become article 167 in the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union once the Lisbon Treaty enters into force.**
- **European Parliament and Council Decision no 1855/2006 EC of 12 December 2006, published in the OJ**

- Funding possibilities to all cultural sections and categories of cultural operators

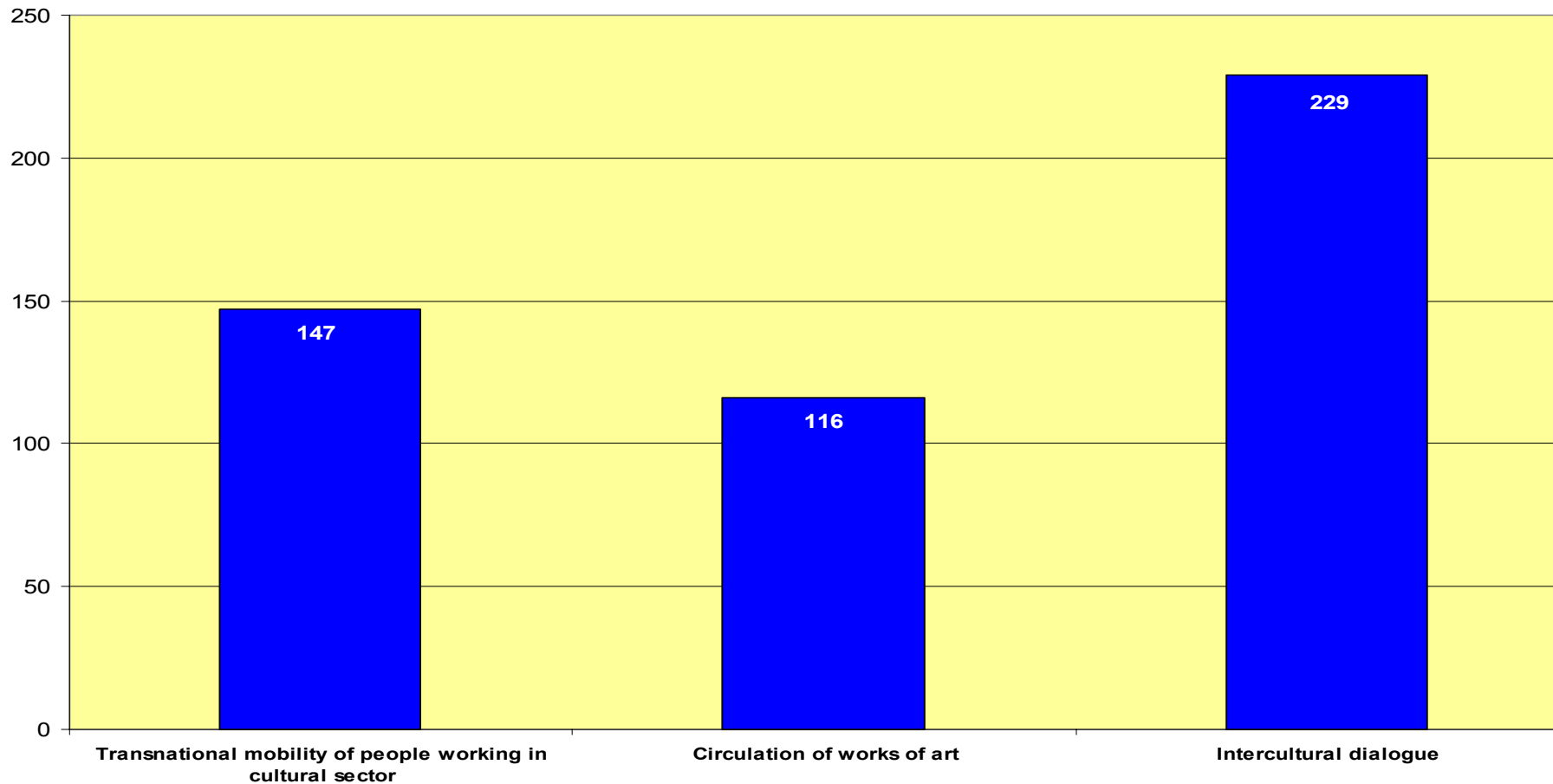


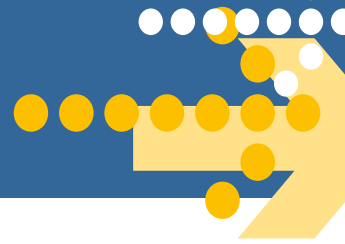
Three specific aims

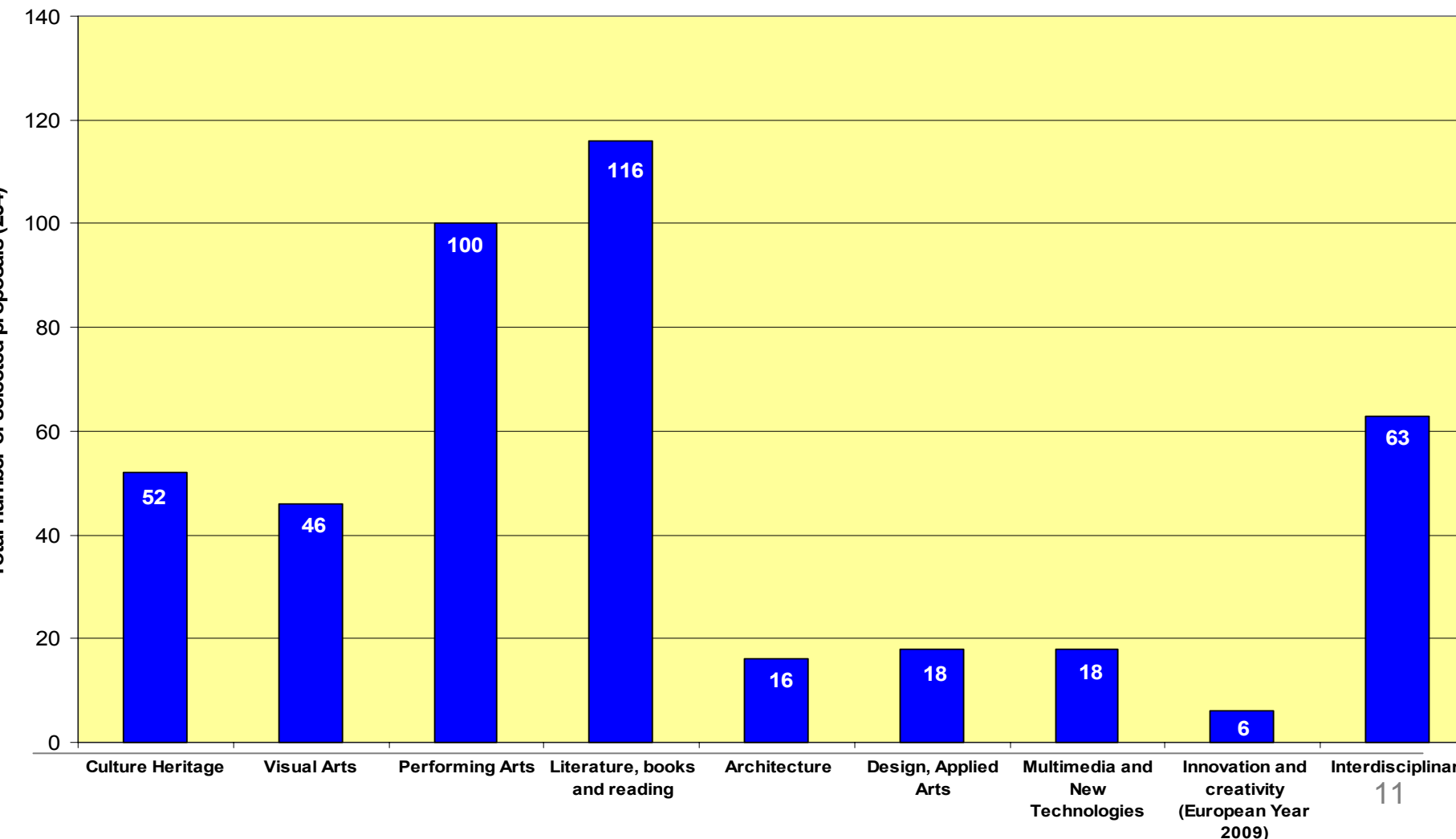

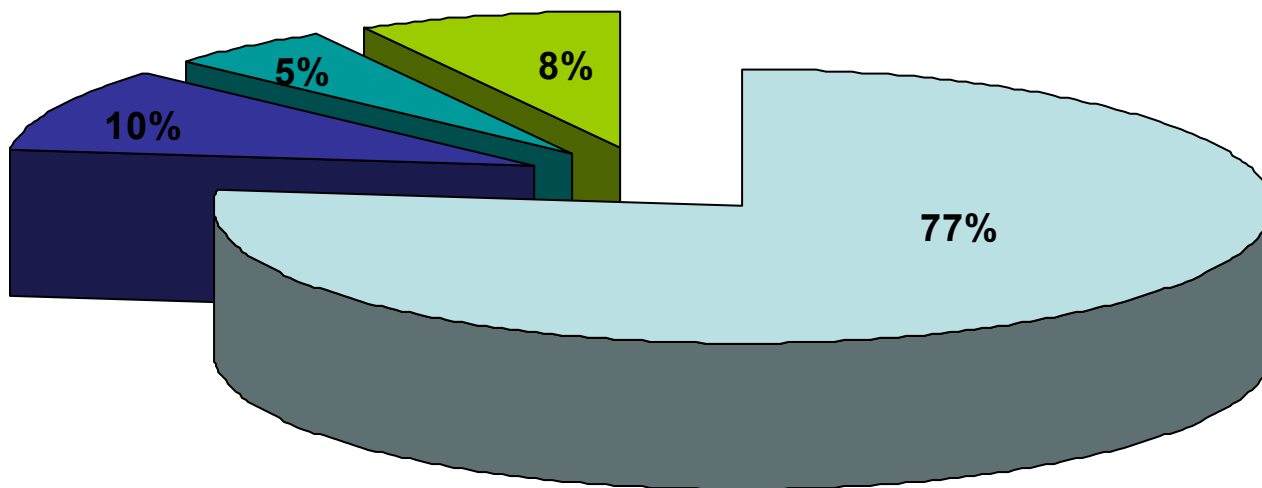

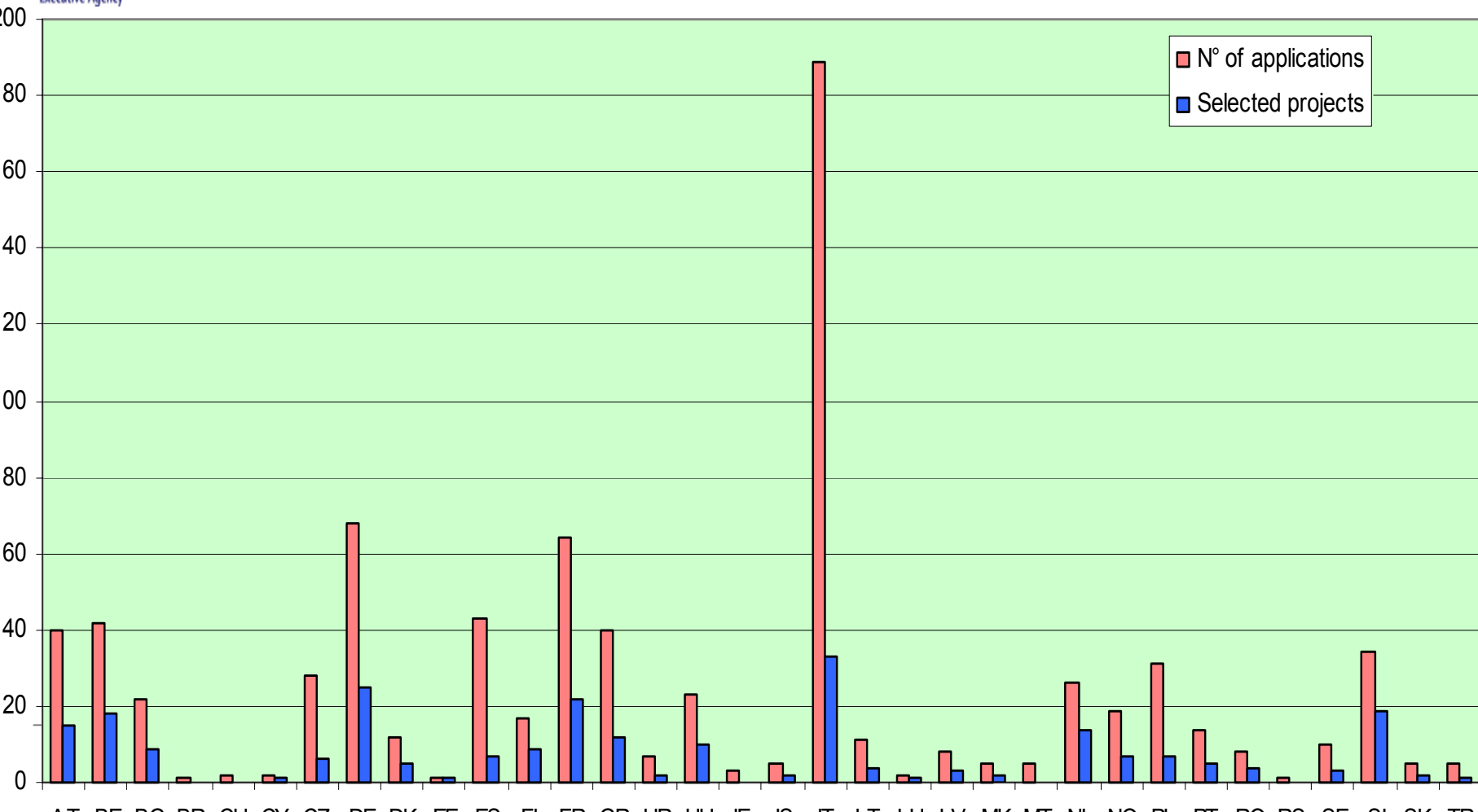

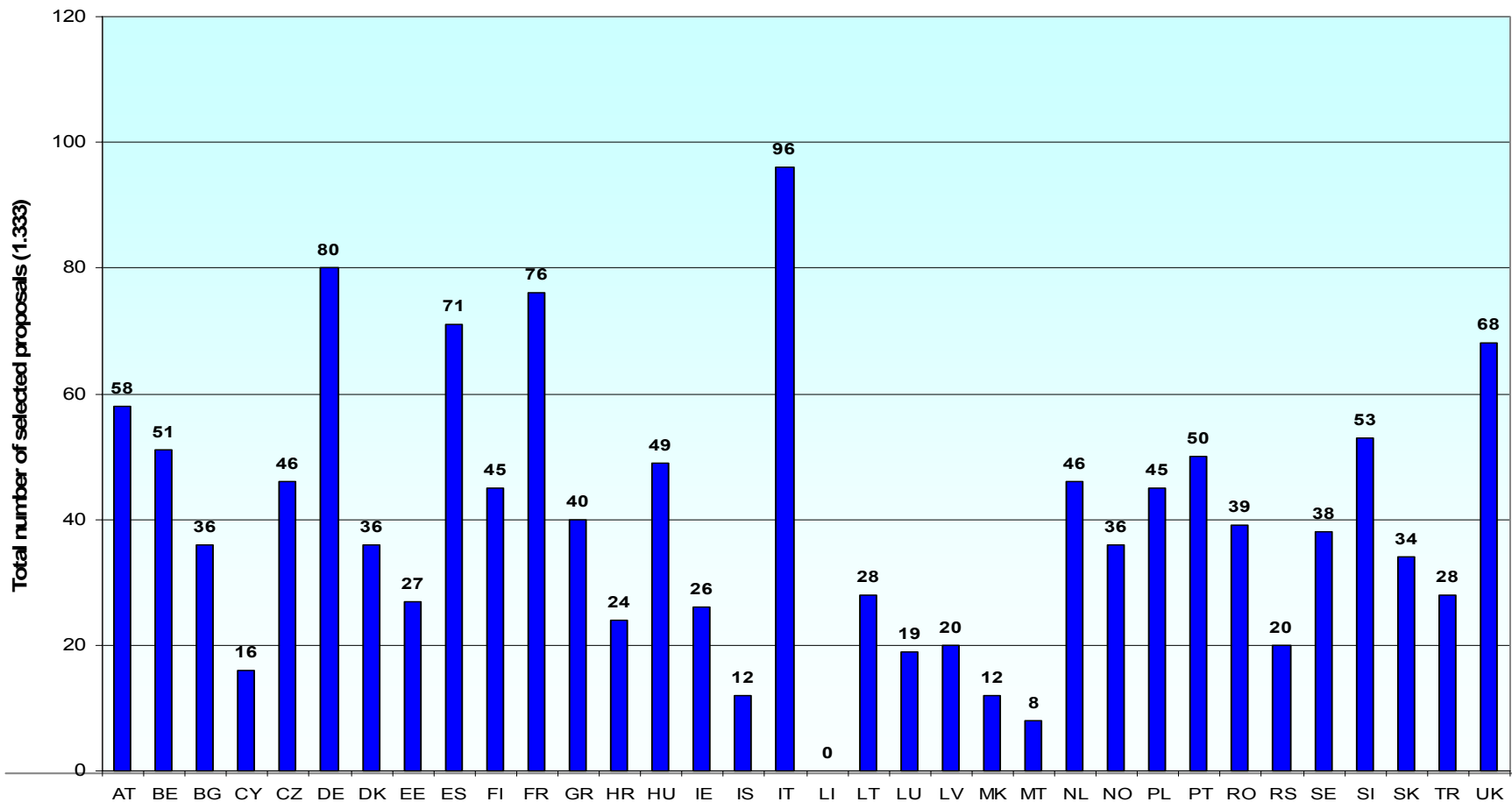


Culture Programme 2007-2013 (including strands 1.1, 1.2.1, 2, 1.2.2, 1.3)
Number of applications by country (total: 819) + Successful applications (total: 264)



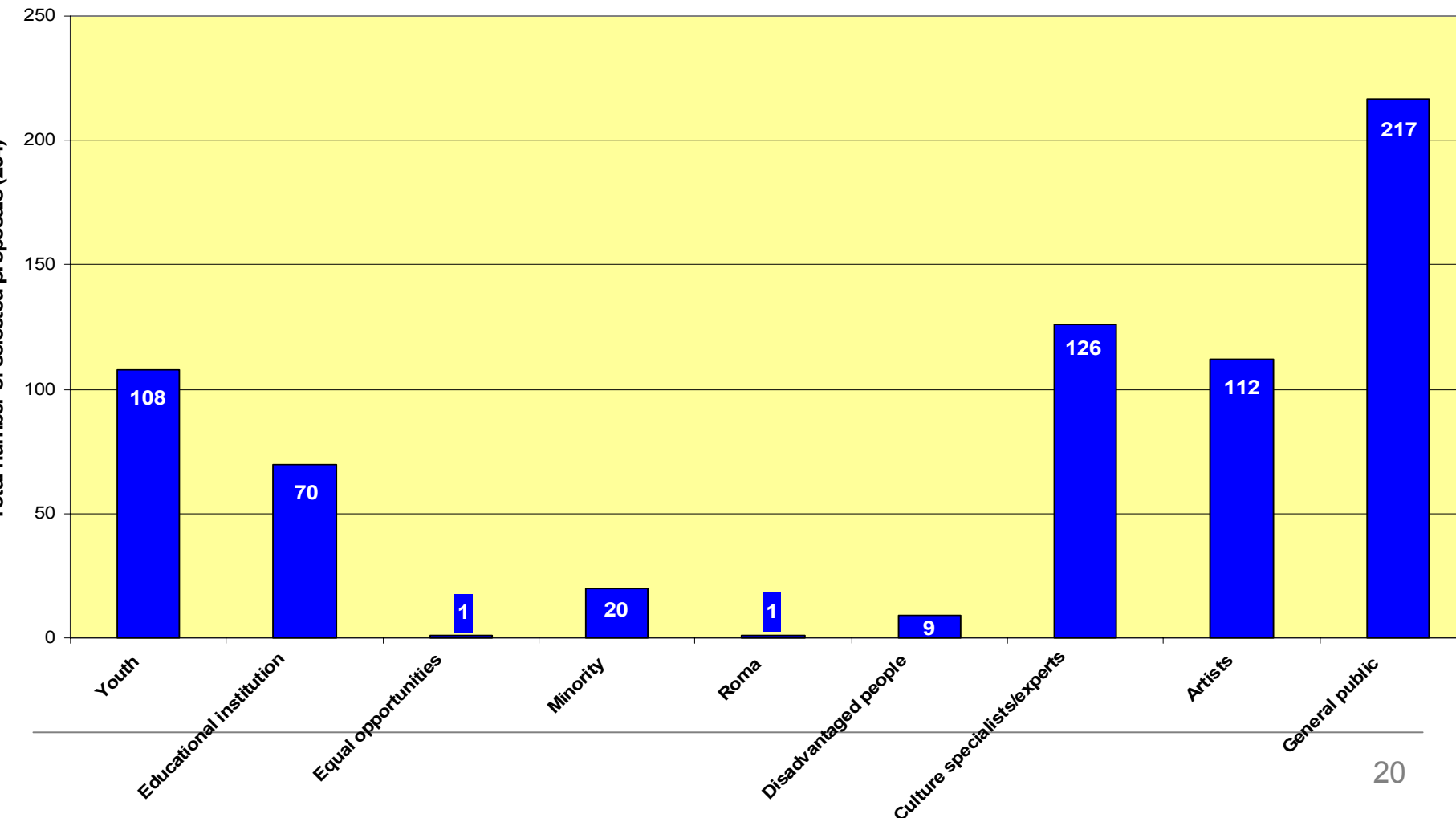
